

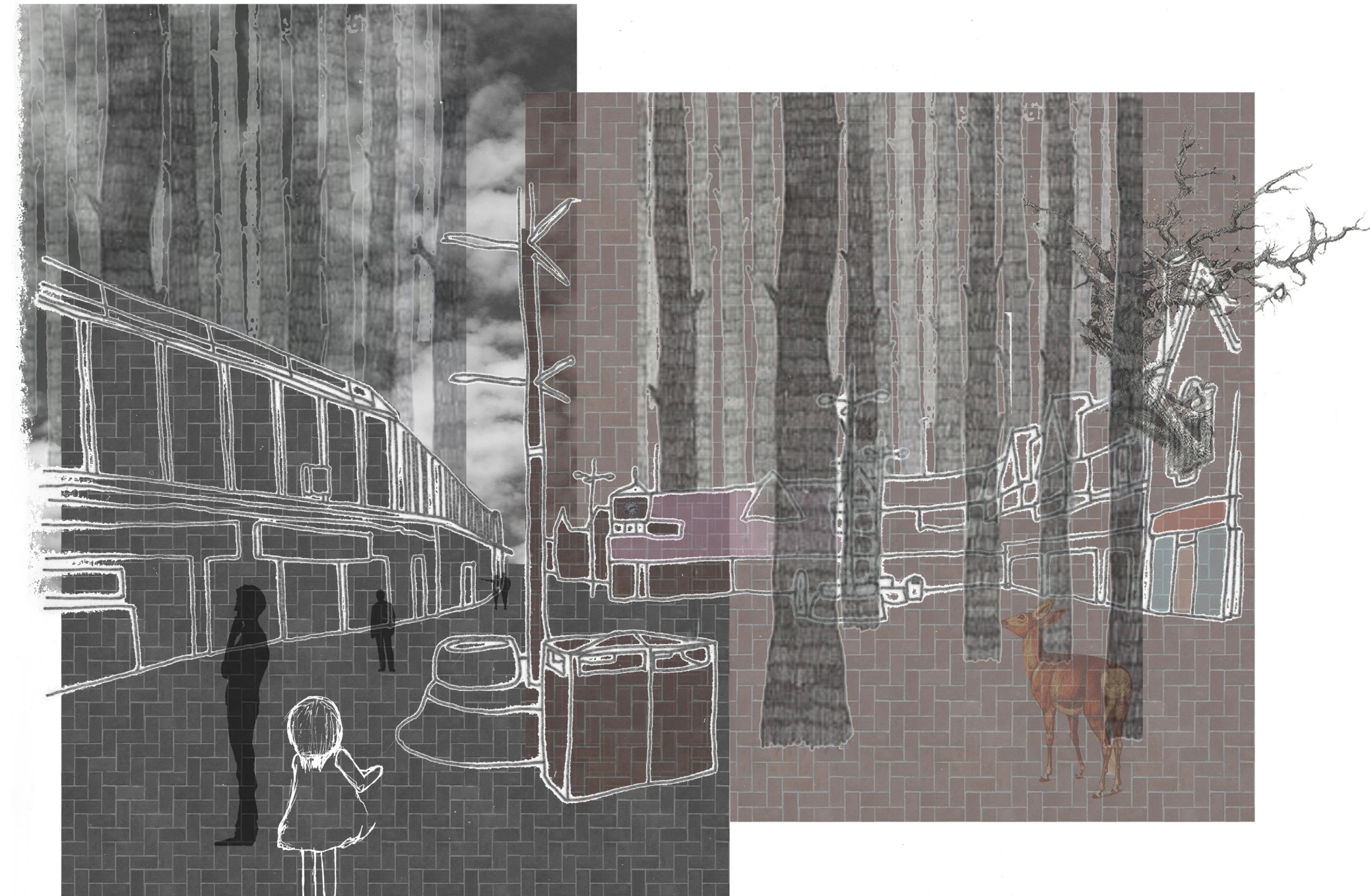
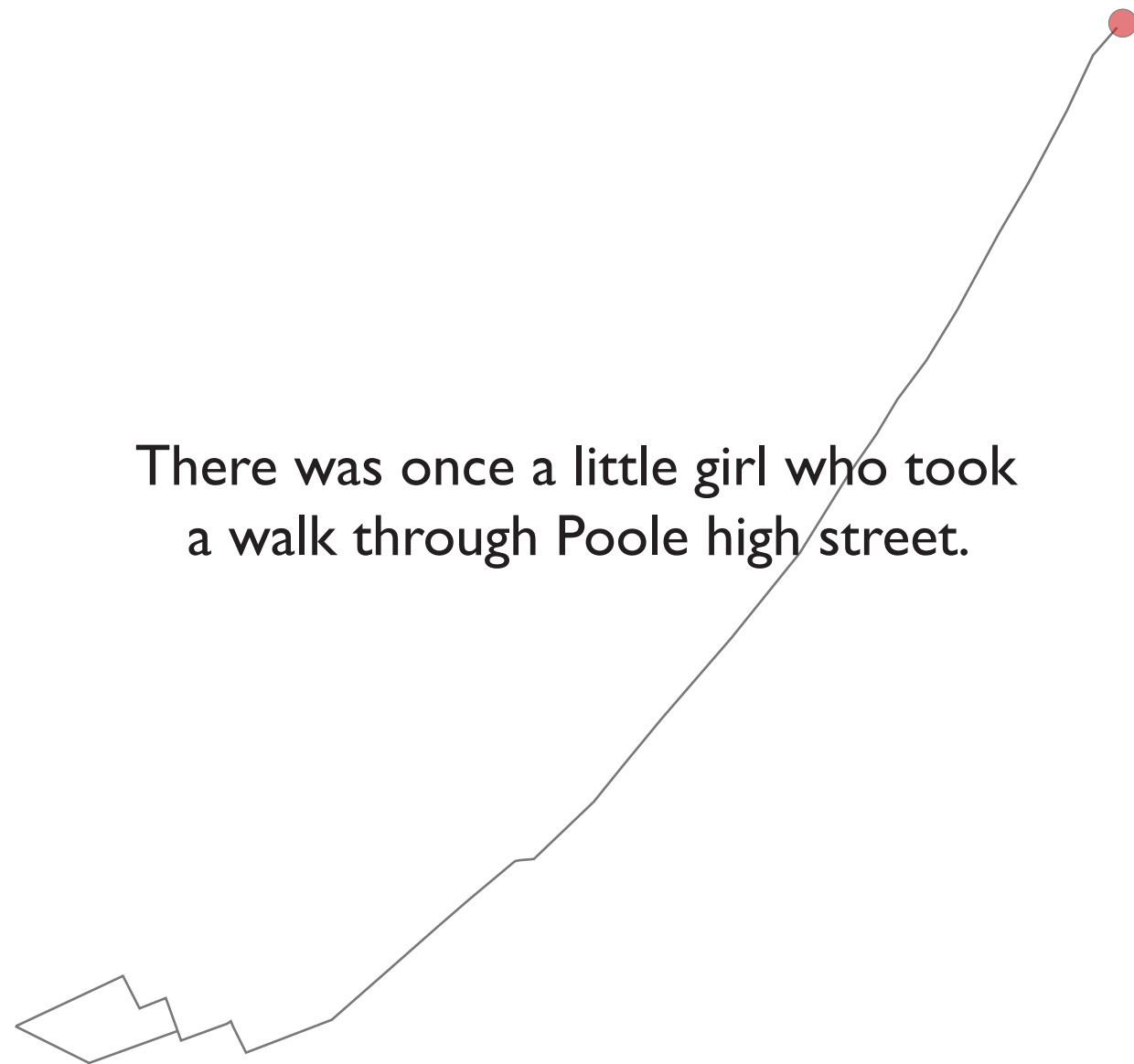


Serial vision route

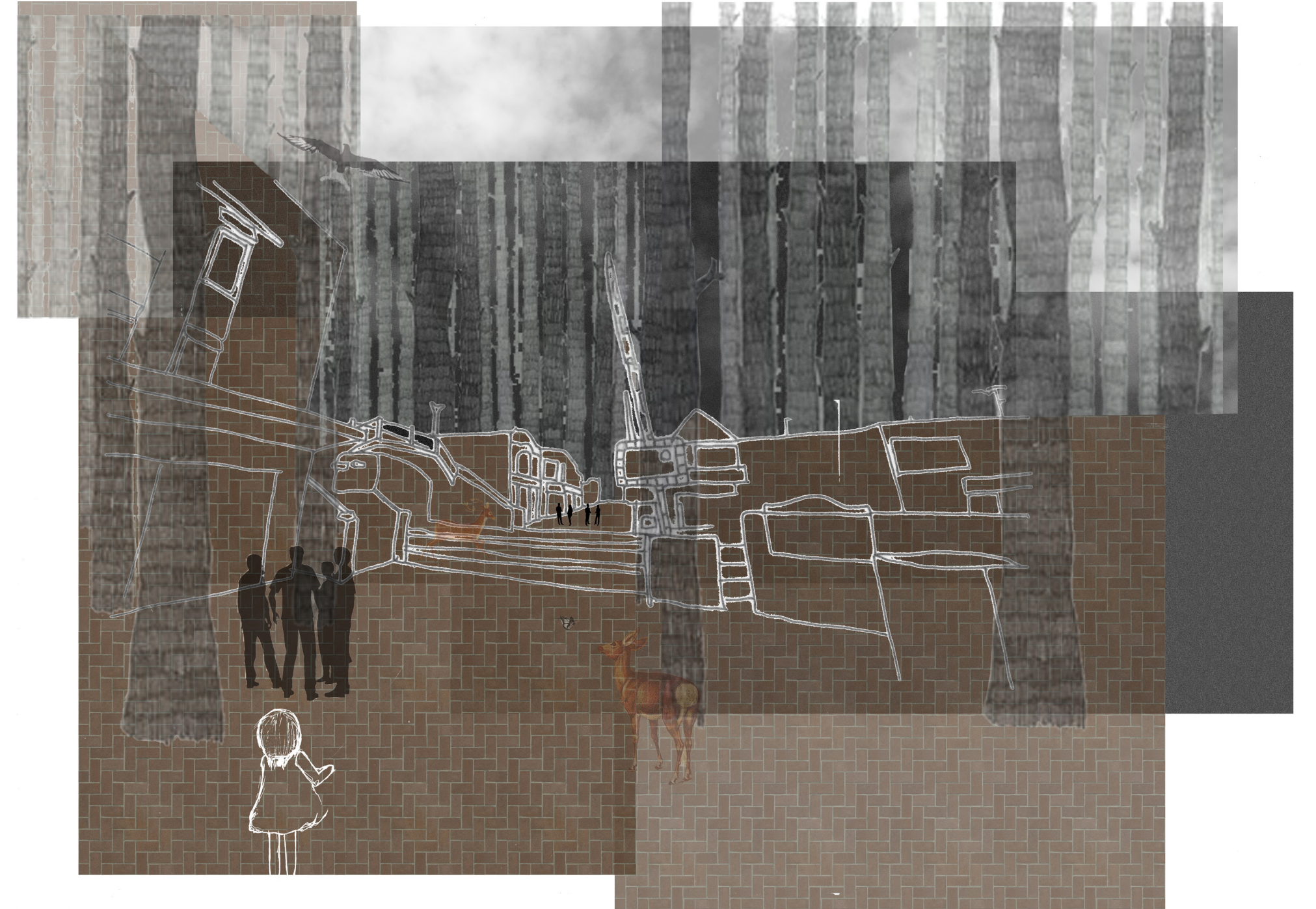
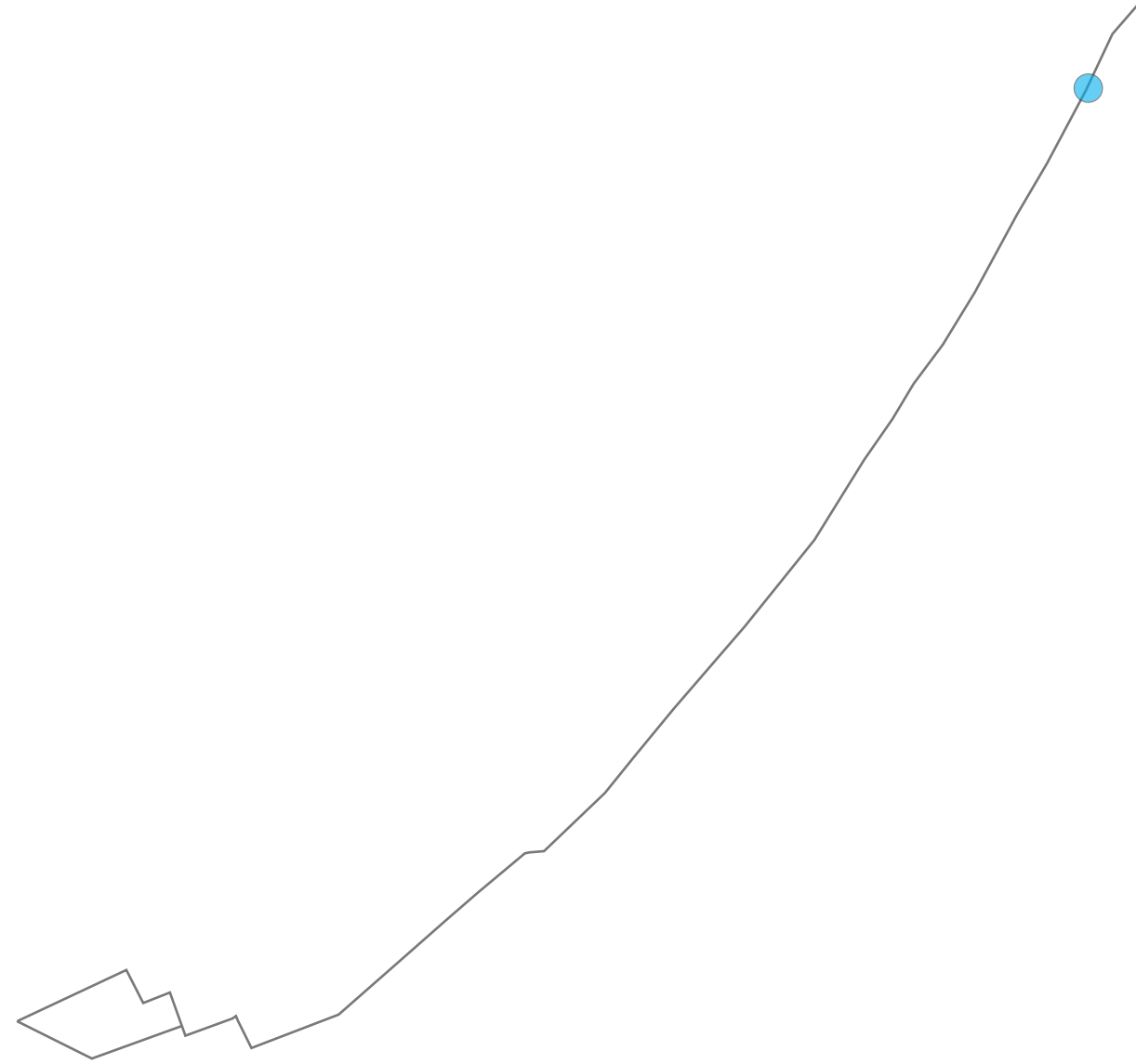




There was once a little girl who took

went onwards.

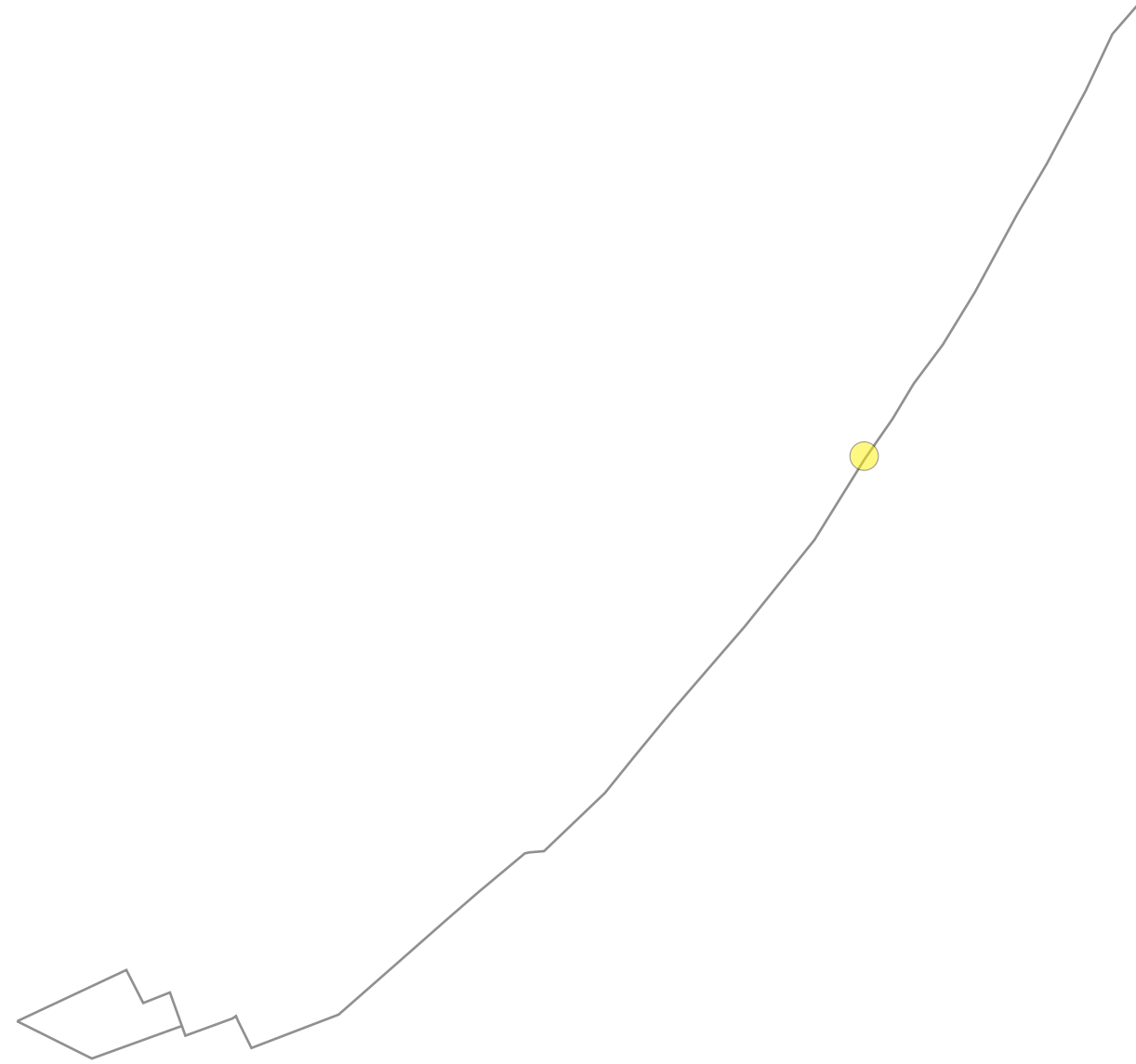




Then came a child who moaned and

cold English days and nights”.







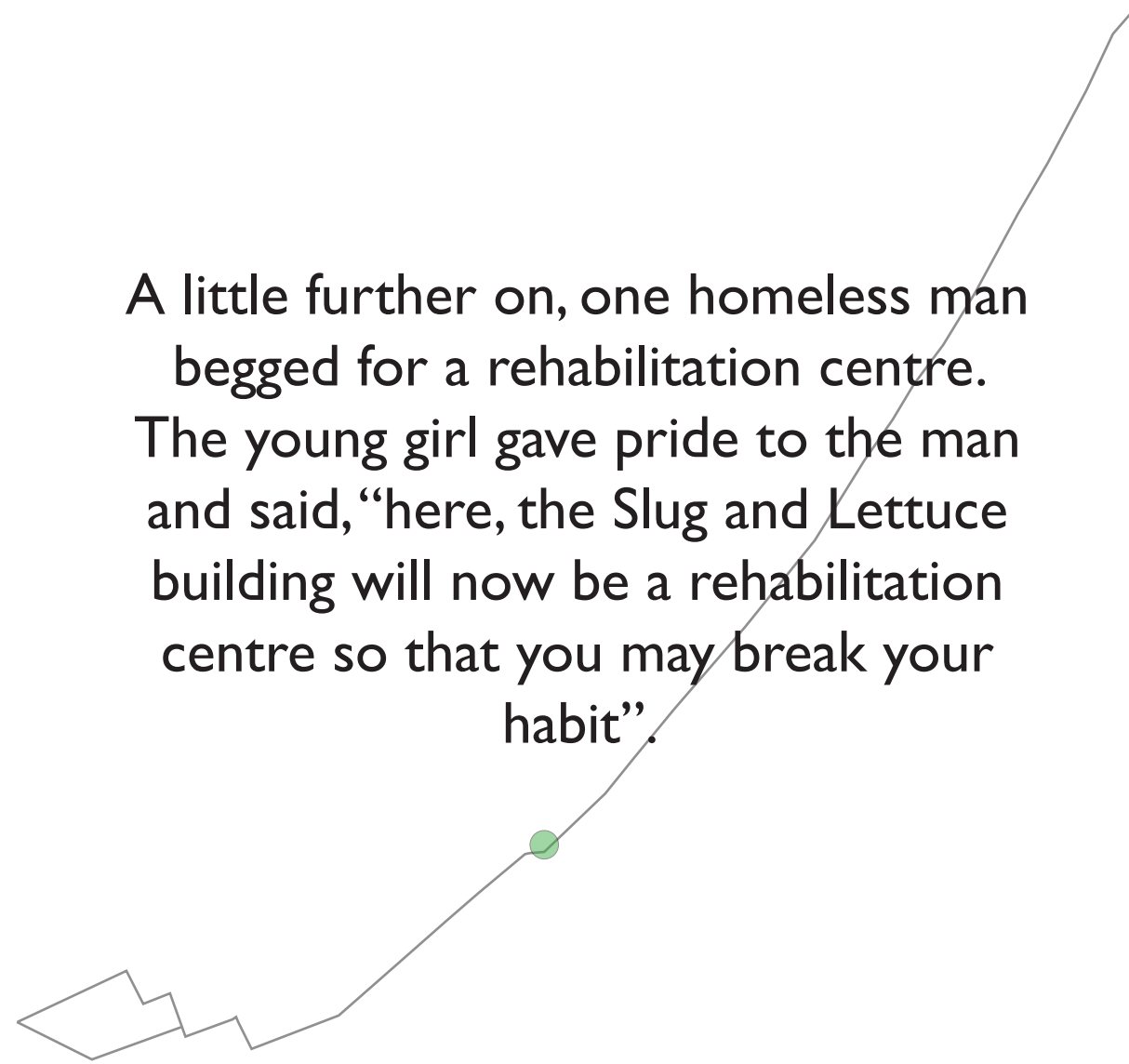


And when she had walked a little

homeless shelter.

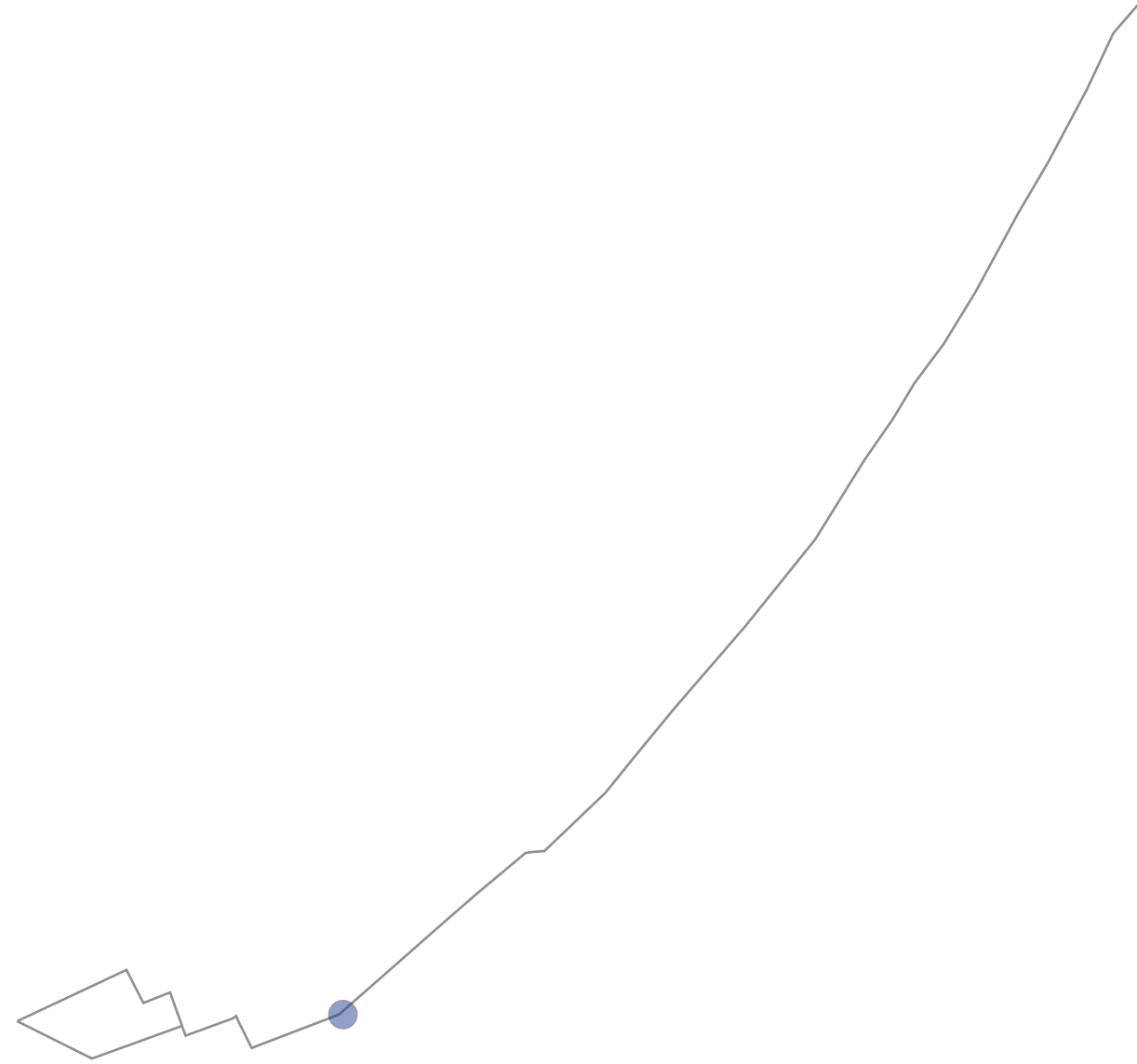

The extortionate prices of the lots on the high street have caused many businesses to be forced out and the high street is becoming more and more derelict. ‘Star Coins’ would cause a renovation of the high street focusing on Poole’s issues of homelessness and poverty. The building itself focuses on the concept of play allowing a greater focus on the currently neglected young people within Poole. The building will also contain emergency shared housing for families and youths with little support networks, allowing them a place to learn, work and play. The addition of ‘Star Coins’ to Poole and the consequential changes to the high street, will allow families to gain a new beginning and happily ever after.
